

CALL FOR (2) RESEARCH ASSISTANTS

Project Description

The University of the Philippines Manila College of Public Health, in collaboration with the National University of Singapore – Saw Swee Hock School of Public Health, will be studying the challenges in implementation of national action plans on Antimicrobial Resistance in the Philippines. This is funded by the Asia Pacific Observatory on Health Systems and Policies and part of a regional research collaboration work. The project team is looking for research support who could assist in the collection and analysis of information from various sources, including a review of policy documents, interviews with stakeholders, social mapping, and procurement of project-related approvals in the country.

Duration: Four months contract of service (September - December 2020)

Deliverables:

- Support the research team in obtaining project-related submissions to relevant offices
- 2. Identifying and contacting relevant stakeholders for the project
- 3. Daily submission of the assigned tasks on either data collection, presentation or analysis of data as requested by UP-CPH
- 4. Prepare written and/or oral presentations as requested by UP-CPH

Qualifications:

- Having graduate level units/education is an advantage but not required
- Should be willing to work on-site and online to conduct data collection
- Must have a personal computer with a reliable internet connection
