Essentials of Project Management in the Health Sector Short Course

For: Physicians, dentists, nurses, medical technologists, nutritionist-dietitians, physical therapists, occupational therapists, speech pathologists, midwives, sanitarians, teachers, professors, academicians, researchers, staff personnel

The use of projects in the health sector, primarily aimed at implementing organizational or service delivery changes, has notably increased in the previous decade. However, there is a general feeling of frustration among managers and project staff alike because attained results may not always be commensurate with the resources and effort expended during the different phases of the project. One major challenge identified in the literature is the apparent extrapolation and extension of general and program management frameworks and techniques for use in project management. This course will present a model for project management, and will equip the attendees with the necessary methods,
